## Introduction

After one of the hardest funding years in a decade, widespread budget cuts, hiring stops and retrenchments, the tech hiring market now favours the employer.

However, this reality has not yet reached all job seekers, and it doesn't necessarily mean that finding the right fit has become any easier. This is made even harder for many teams working with less support and tighter hiring budgets.

To help make benchmarking salary ranges easier, we've put together this salary report using incoming data from over 2990 South African developers who took part in our ongoing Developer Nation Survey.

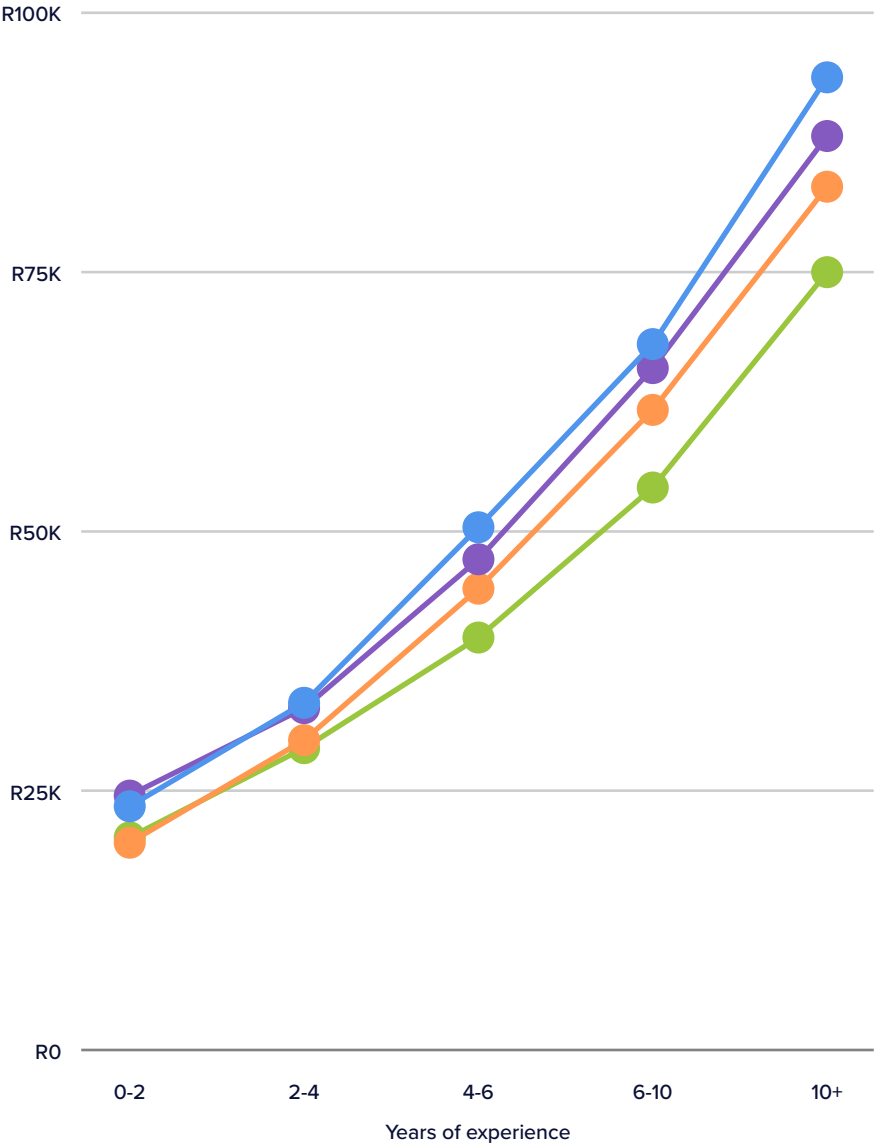
# Senior developers are more expensive in 2024

As mentioned in the introduction, the current cool down hasn't made hiring developers any easier. It's also not made hiring good ones any cheaper.

This is especially true if you're hiring for seniors and leads in the new year. Senior developers with at least six years of experience earn an average monthly salary of R67 863, up 3% from the previous year.

Seniors with more than a decade under their belts saw a 6.3% increase over the same period, bringing their average salaries up to R93 986.

Taking a closer look at the data indicates that salary increases for developers have slowed in recent years.



Average software developer salaries by experience

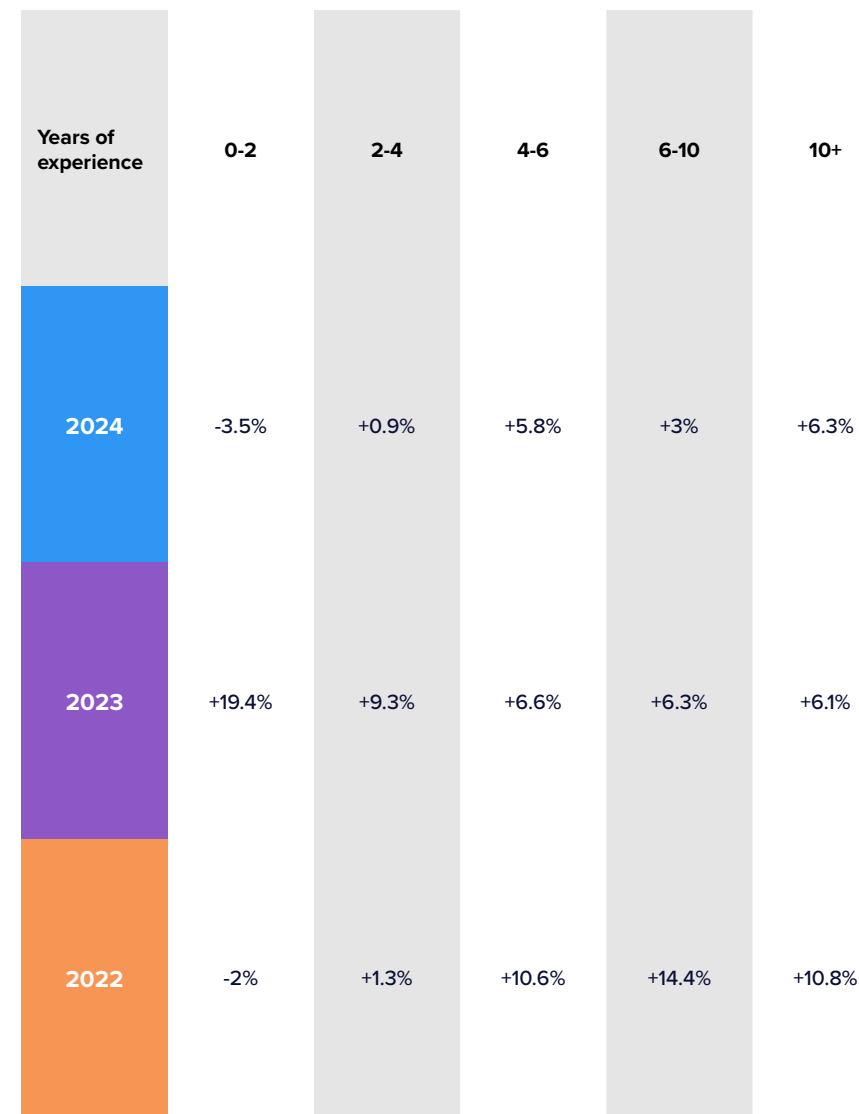

# Annual salary growth has fallen since 2022

While salaries for seniors have risen over the past twelve months, the impact of the current cool down can be seen in how average increases have changed over the past two years.

Developers with six years of experience saw a 3% increase between 2023 and 2024, down from a 14.4% increase two years ago.

For those with more than ten years of experience, their increases have remained fairly stable over the past twelve months but still down from 2022.



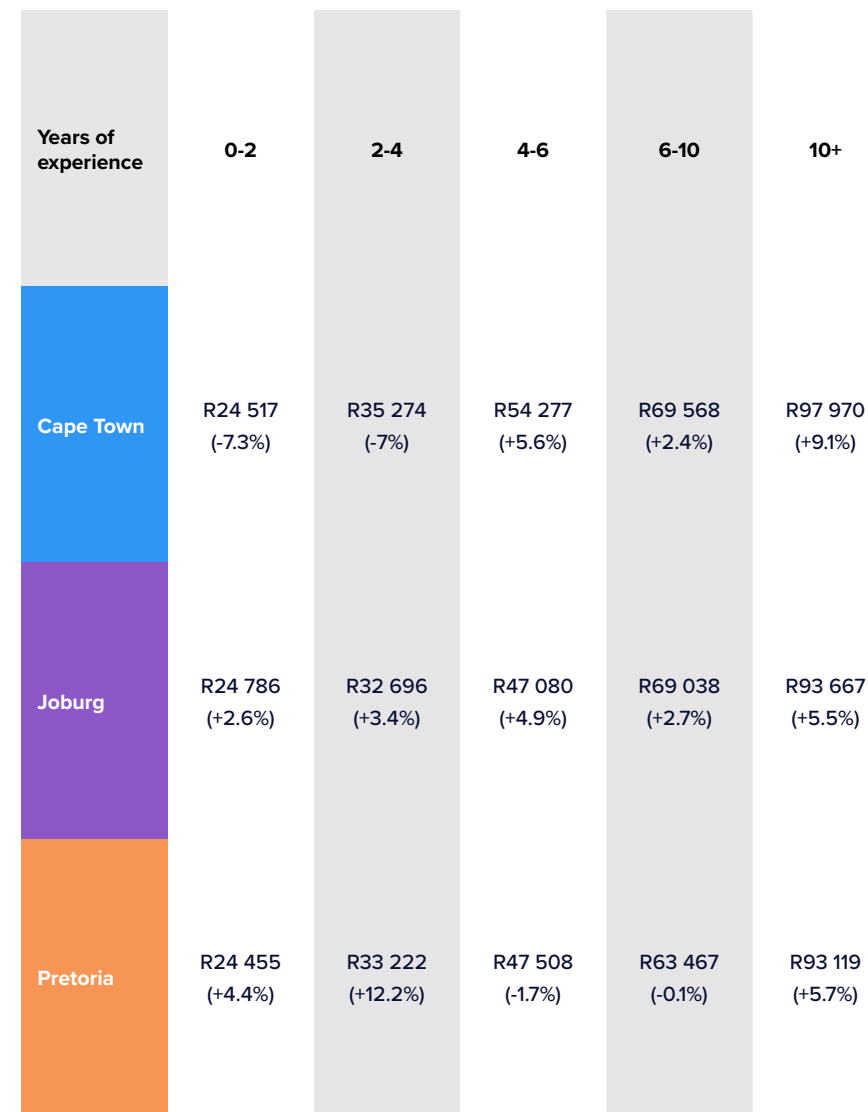
Average software developer salary increases

## Salaries in Gauteng are catching up with Cape Town

If you're hiring across different tech hubs, it's useful to keep in mind that each of SA's tech hubs has its own compensation benchmarks.

For example, Cape Town's higher cost of living means that developers there will expect a higher base salary, making it more expensive to offer a standout salary in the city.

Even though the gap between Cape Town and other tech hubs has been shrinking over the years, you can still use the local salary difference to your advantage: if you're hiring developers outside of the major tech hubs, you'll be able to offer a standout salary to a great candidate that is still more budget-friendly for you.

## FinTech and Consulting pay the highest average salaries

Developers in FinTech have the highest average salaries, making developers with FinTech experience more expensive to hire than SaaS or Cloud developers. Likewise, experience in Consulting will also come at a premium, especially for seniors with more than ten years of experience.

These sectors typically include enterprise companies like banks and large multinational firms, which typically pay higher salaries than smaller companies.

## Growth and culture can give smaller companies an edge

While larger companies tend to be able to offer higher average salaries and more comprehensive benefits than smaller companies, that doesn't mean small companies can't have attractive job packages.

If you're hiring for a startup and aren't able to keep up with market-related salary benchmarks, highlight other benefits and factors developers care about. Growth opportunities, an exciting tech stack, a great company culture and interesting business problems are among developers' most important factors when weighing up a job offer. In many cases, startups may have an edge in these categories.

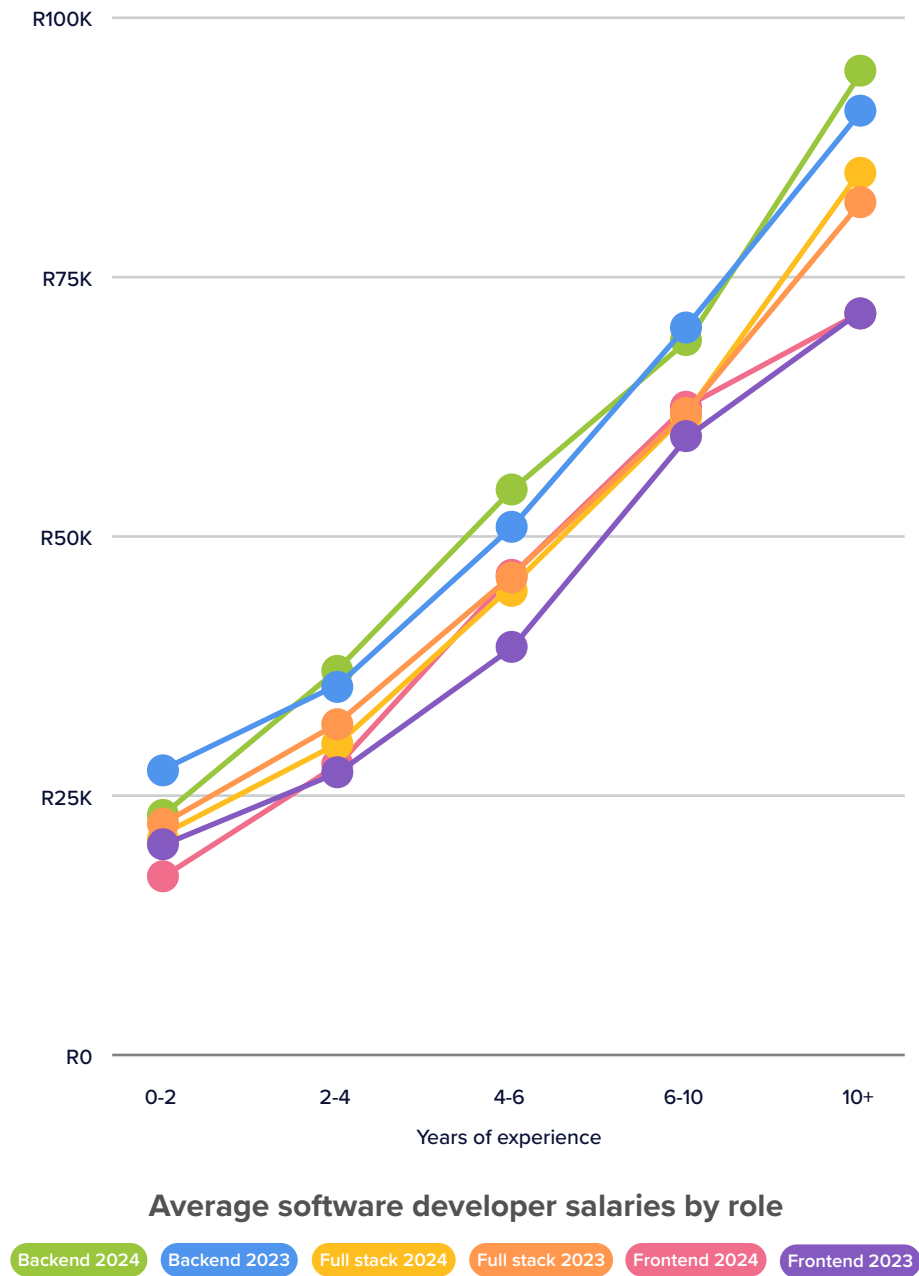

## Specialist skillsets earn more than generalist ones

If you're looking to fill backend roles, you'll need to offer more than if you're hiring for frontend or full stack developers. On average, backend developers will cost you 15% more than full stack and 25% more than frontend developers.

However, the gap between full stack and frontend developers has narrowed considerably, partly due to salaries for full stack developers stagnating over the past year.

Full stack developers might be a more affordable option if you're looking for a combination of backend and frontend skills.





# Go, Ruby and Kotlin developers have the highest-paying skillsets

Over the past few years, [Go and Kotlin have become more popular](#) in South Africa's tech ecosystem.

Despite this growth, finding experienced developers working with these tools remains tough, and this is reflected in them earning the highest average salaries. The same is true for companies hiring Ruby developers, which also remains a niche skillset in 2024.

## Spring Boot and Spring are the best-paying frameworks for senior developers

Frameworks also impact what a given skillset earns.

Spring and Spring Boot have the highest average salaries among frameworks and lead to higher average salaries for Java developers across the majority of their careers.

JavaScript developers can also earn more by gaining experience with widely-used frameworks like React or Node.js.

# AWS is still the best-paying cloud skill in 2024

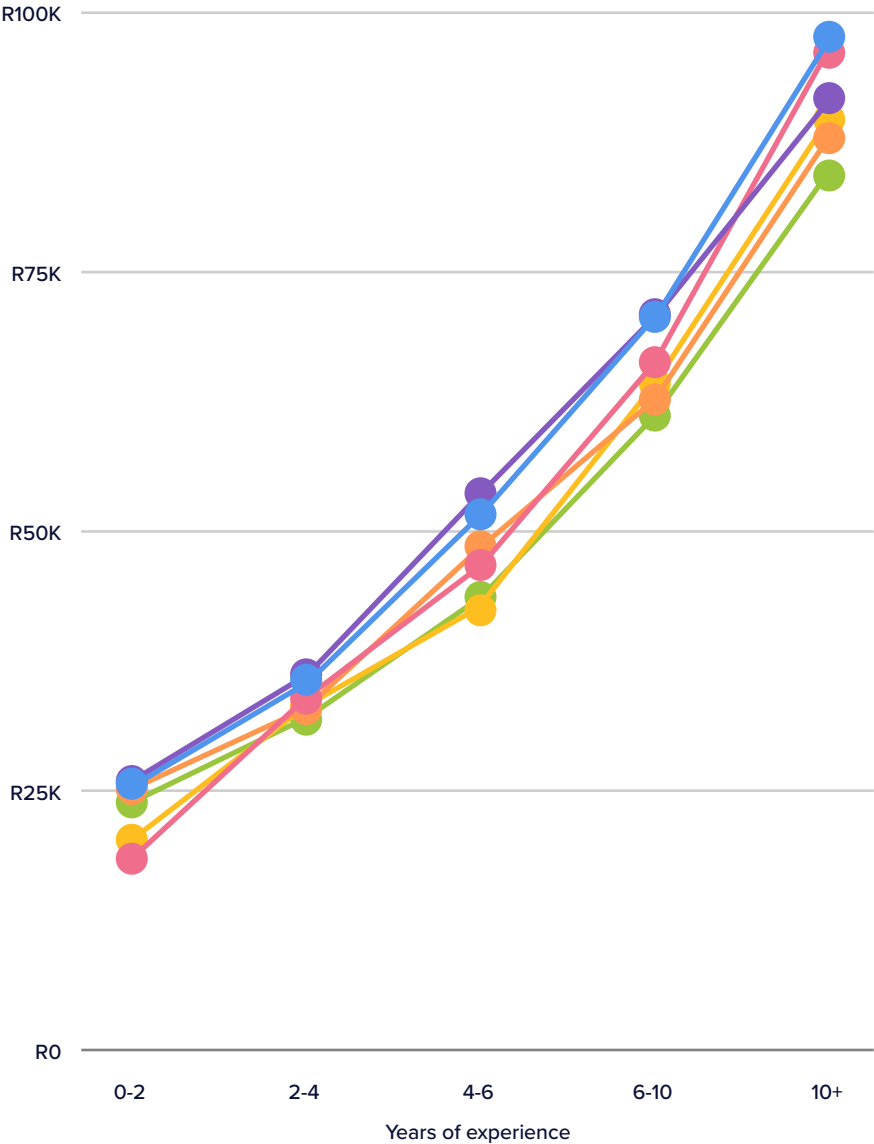
AWS knowledge is another skill that remains in demand, and that’s reflected in AWS having the highest average salaries among South African cloud platforms.

Despite demand for AWS remaining strong, salaries for AWS developers with less than ten years of experience have stagnated. Google Cloud developers, on the other hand, have seen their average salaries increase for developers who have passed the two-year mark.
