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




JOB MARKET ACTIVITY

MONTHLY JOB POSTINGS

Vacancies (seasonally adjusted)



Month-on-month local hiring activity was up **+12%** from September to October 2024.

Year-on-year, hiring activity remains down, with a decrease of **-1%**, compared to October 2023.

The trend for the two-year comparison is more positive, revealing that recruitment activity has increased by **+6%** compared to October 2022.


TRENDING JOB SECTORS



AVERAGE STAY BY CANDIDATES IN THEIR JOBS



2021–2024 SALARY TRENDS UNCOVERED

WHO'S WINNING AND LOSING?

Salary offers fluctate based on demand for labour and supply of labour. Naturally, skills and professions that are high in demand with a limited supply pool tend to receive higher salaries compared to professions with an oversupply of talent and little demand.





Pnet has examined salary offers over the past three years with the objective of understanding:

WHO ARE THE BIGGEST WINNERS AND LOSERS IN TERMS OF SALARY OFFERS OVER THE LAST THREE YEARS?

In other words:

- Which professionals are being offered higher salaries than they were 3 years ago?
- Which professionals are being offered much lower salaries than they were 3 years ago?

To allow for a fair comparison of salaries over time, all analysed professions were based on advertised vacancies for intermediate-level job roles based in Gauteng. Vacancies for junior or senior level roles were excluded from the sample, as well as roles outside of Gauteng.

The Biggest Winner

SALARY OFFERS FOR LOGISTITICS MANAGEMENT PROFESSIONALS INCREASED BY UP TO +48%.

Demand for Warehousing & Logistics professionals has been on an increase: Year-on-year, demand for these professionals has increased by **+5%**. Over the 3-year period (2021–2024), demand for Warehousing & Logistics professionals has increased by **+16%**.

Focusing on demand for Logisitics Management professionals specifically, demand has increased by **+22%** over the last 3 years.

Looking at 2021, professionals in logistics management were offered between **R29 000** and **R47 000 CTC** on average per month. Today (2024), logistics managers can expect to be offered between **R43 000 and R56 000 CTC** on average per month.

Looking at this trend, it becomes clear that companies are willing to offer up to 48% higher salaries (compared to 3 years ago) to attract skilled and qualified Logistics Managers.

The Biggest Loser

SALARY OFFERS FOR IT PROJECT MANAGERS DECREASED BY UP TO -30%.

Demand for IT professionals has declined significantly over the last 3 years.

Year-on-year, this sector has seen a decline of **-21%**, and over the past three years recruitment activity in this sector has decreased by **-40%**.

The decrease in local demand for IT professionals has been fuelled by the global trend of tech layoffs. Retrenchments and job cuts by global giants in the IT sector were first announced at the end of 2022. Companies like **Google, Amazon** and Meta (Facebook) reduced their Tech staff counts significantly back then. This trend has continued and is **still very prevalent in 2024**. Google and Amazon are still on the list when it comes to tech layoffs, but other companies like Tesla, Tik Tok, Microsoft and other companies are also decreasing their Tech staff size in 2024.

Focusing on demand for IT Project Managers, demand decreased by **-30%** over the last 3 years. As a result, salary offers decreased from about **R54 000 to R80 000** (CTC) per month on average in 2021 to **R44 000 to R56 000** (CTC) per month on average in 2024.

With the decline in demand for IT Project Managers, average salary offers dropped as companies need to be less competitive when looking for these professionals.

REGIONAL JOB TRENDS

A regional view on the latest job market trends. Here we take a closer look at three different provinces every month.

WESTERN CAPE

Top in-demand professionals:

- Finance
- Business & Management
- IT
- Admin, Office & Support

Over the last 3 months, recruitment activity increased by **+21%** for Building & Construction professionals. Year-on-year, Western Cape hiring activity rose by **+77%** in the Building & Construction sector.

NORTHERN CAPE

Top in-demand professionals:

- Business & Management
- Architecture & Engineering
- **■** Finance
- Admin, Office & Support

The Northern Cape has seen a +97% increase in hiring activity for Business & Management professionals over the last 3 months (August, September, October 2024) compared to the previous 3 months (May, June, July 2024).

Year-on-year, there has been a +57% increases in recruitment for Business & Management professional in this province.

NORTH WEST

Top in-demand professionals:

- **■** Business & Management
- **■** Finance

Recruitment for Business & Management professionals has also increased in the North West province over the last year.

Year-on-year, there has been **+17%** growth in recruitment for Business & Management staff.

Aside from hiring for Business & Management staff, recruitment for Sales professionals also increased by +44% (year-on-year) in the North West province.
